

Policy Influence

Qisda actively participates in various associations to strengthen the industrial linkage and development. The company continuously focusing important issues¹ including M&A, industrial development, technology innovation, corporate governance, and sustainable environment.

Qisda has committed to reducing supply chain emissions by 30% by 2030, to fully use renewable electricity by 2040, and to reach net zero emissions by 2050, so as to keep in line with international trends and practice the goal of corporate sustainability. In 2023, Qisda also established Qisda Climate Change Statement, publicly disclosing its climate-related promise, policy, and strategies on the Qisda Corporate Sustainability website. Each year, we conduct an assessment of our climate change positions related to the local and international industry associations we participate in, and complete a climate lobbying report accordingly.

In response to global climate initiatives and the growing impacts of climate change, Qisda actively engages with climate action organizations and initiatives both domestically and internationally. Aligned with the Paris Agreement and its objective of limiting global warming to 1.5°C, Qisda has established 2021 as its baseline year and is committed to reducing Scope 1 and Scope 2 greenhouse gas emissions by 42%, as well as Scope 3 emissions by 25%, by 2030.

To strengthen climate governance and align its management practices with internationally recognized sustainability standards, Qisda partnered with S&P Global in 2025 to integrate the Corporate Sustainability Assessment (CSA) framework into its supply chain management system. As the first company in Asia to collaborate with S&P Global in promoting sustainability alignment across its supply chain, Qisda is advancing the adoption of global sustainability standards among suppliers, enhancing supply chain ESG performance, expanding its positive sustainability impact, and accelerating the development and adoption of low-carbon products.

Qisda actively monitors biodiversity-related issues and developments. Through

exchanges with domestic industry and academic organizations, Qisda officially joined the “Nature and Biodiversity Initiative Platform” launched by the Business Council for Sustainable Development of Taiwan (BCSD-Taiwan) in October 2023 to review the company’s current response to nature-related issues.

In 2025, Qisda released its Forest Sustainability and Biodiversity Commitment, aiming to achieve a net positive impact on biodiversity by 2050 while ending all forms of deforestation. Qisda will continue to reduce its environmental impact and promote greater attention to and protection of nature.

In 2025, Qisda participated in approximately 36 public associations at home and abroad, with a total expenditure of about NT\$ 2.89 million, and the cumulative total expenditure from 2022 to 2025 was NT\$ 16.36 million.
