Policy to Water Resource Management

Qisda recognizes that its operations, products, and services may pose potential impacts on the environment and stakeholders. In fulfilling its corporate social responsibility and exerting positive influence, Qisda is proactively addressing the issue of water scarcity. With a focus on enhancing the resilience of water resource management, Qisda aims to strengthen its capacity to respond and adapt to future water-related challenges. - Committed to improving water use efficiency by prioritizing the
 procurement of water-saving equipment, promoting water-saving
 behaviors, and preventing waste. Concrete targets are set to reduce
 water withdrawal and consumption volumes.
